



Co-UDlabs Hackathon

Innovative ideas for sustainable urban drainage

November 23 and 25, 2021

Co-UDlabs is a H2020 EU-funded project with nine partners from seven European countries and **a research infrastructure of 17 installations**. The project aims to use its facilities, expertise, and research agenda to **develop innovative ideas, methods, and technologies in urban drainage sustainability** and resilience. We have a [Transnational Access call](#) open: user groups can already submit proposals for **free-of-charge research stays** at any of our facilities for up to three months.

This Hackathon seeks to **identify and share valuable ideas** that may tackle the most challenging problems that urban drainage systems are facing today. The Hackathon can be an **excellent opportunity to build synergies, teams, and improved project ideas** and designs.

We recommend that you [register for the Hackathon now](#): you will be able to participate either as an individual or a member of an already-formed team or user group. You will also be able to **'brainstorm' with Co-UDlabs staff and other participants** in order to develop an idea or **meet with the providers of a specific facility** if you already have an idea and want to find out how to improve or streamline it.

Once you have registered for the event, you can already [access the Miro Board platform](#) we have created for the Hackathon: you'll be able to **share ideas, expertise, or issues that you think are concerning for UDS stakeholders**. You can also look for more teammates and insight on ideas and proposals. The password is: @PiV2021

At the Hackathon, you will be able to present your idea, get to know the **facility providers** and discuss in detail **the added value** of our installations, and **seek partners** and new team members for a more detailed Transnational Access proposal.

The best idea will be **awarded with a short visit to their facility of choice**, so that you can streamline and improve your TA proposal.
